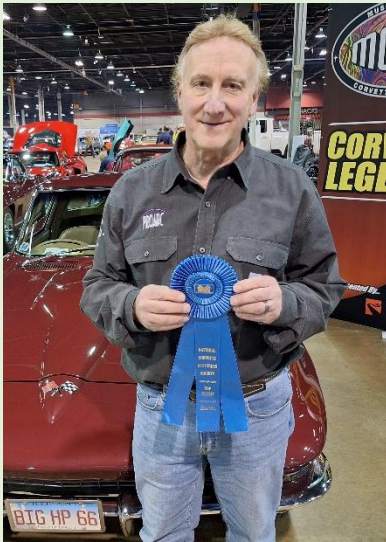

What Year Body is This?

What Year Body do I Have – 1953, 54 or 55?

Back in June of this year, Scott K. posted this question to the Corvette Forum. He acquired this Corvette body from his brother Steve, who had passed away. Scott's brother owned the body for over 25 years and said it was a 1953. There was no chassis or parts with the car to help verify the year. The photos appear to show a Corvette Copper color which would be from 1955. As we know, these cars have probably been painted several times over the past 70 years. If it was copper, it would be extremely rare as only 15 were produced out of a total of 700 Corvettes for 1955.



Chris Sherman of our chapter reached out to Scott and had a lengthy phone conversation with him. Chris did note that the picture of the interior showed what appeared to be the transmission and shifter cover plate for a 1955 Corvette 3 speed. It is said that only the last 25 1955 Corvettes were built with RPO 224B, the 3-speed transmission. According to Nolan Adams book, *The Complete Restoration & Technical Guide – Vol. 1*, there were some other 3 speed cars documented prior to the final run but those were built as a pilot study for the late 1955 production run. Prior to late 1955, all of the 1953 and 1954 Corvettes came with a 2-speed Powerglide automatic transmission. The 1955 manual shifter was mounted on the side of the transmission. The 1953, 1954 & 1955 Powerglide shifter was mounted to the fiberglass transmission tunnel.





What Year Body Is This?



Chris reached an agreement to purchase the body and then started planning on how to pick it up. He reached out to me for help as the body was located at a farm in Harmony, MN. It was a true field find. I met up with Chris and we had a nice dinner and a couple of beers. The next morning after breakfast we headed out to the farmstead. Anybody familiar with Harmony, MN knows that it is very hilly and Amish country. Chris had borrowed a utility trailer that would hold the body (around 700#) as a car trailer would be overkill. Good thing he did not bring a car trailer as the farm was up a steep hill and then we had to go up another steep hill to the field. Chris had his 2-wheel drive pickup which is all they need in Illinois. Here in Minnesota, 4-wheel drive is the only way to go. Steve hooked up the trailer to his 4-wheel drive and was able to climb the last incline. There, behind the old barn was the '55 in all its glory. It was sitting on pallets and planks of wood. We were told it had been here for the last four years. Four of us lifted the body onto the trailer and it fit perfectly.



Chris started looking more closely at the Corvette and determined it was originally Harvest Gold with the green dash and eyebrow cover. You could see the original paint on the upper door panel, the windshield channel and where the eyebrow rail cover attaches to the dash. Though not as rare as Corvette Copper, Chevrolet only made 120 Harvest Gold models out of 700 total. Once we loaded all the loose parts in the back of Chris's truck we strapped down the body and headed back to Harmony for lunch and a celebratory beer. When Chris returned to Illinois, he had several friends unload the body onto one of Chris's body carts that he makes for his restoration business.





What Year Body Is This?



Chris brought the '55 to MCACN at the Donald E. Stephens Convention Center in Rosemont, IL as a display and tribute to the family. While at MCACN the car was awarded the Jerry Kohn Memorial Award by Corvette Central. The car will be restored by TIN Restorations and several parts are already in process.

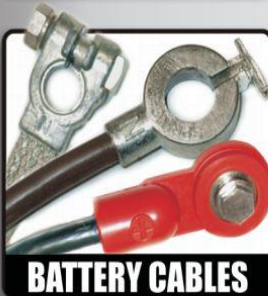
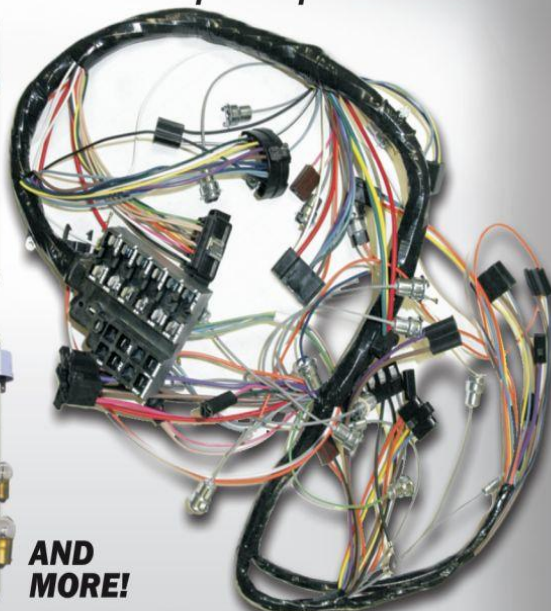
