EAGLE RIDGE RESORT THE GALENA TERRITORY

August 22 - 24, 1986

In a concerted effort to dramatically improve the quality of its annual Chapter meeting and concourse, the Illinois Chapter amended its previous meet policy of one spring and one fall outdoor meet to a single event during August of each year. Plagued by rain nearly every year, and locations within the Chicago metropolitan area which created a disincentive for many Chapter members to make the event a true weekend family happening, the Chapter surveyed membership and as a result, selected Eagle Ridge Resort and Inn, located in the Galena Territory, Galena, Illinois, as the site for its 1986 event, "Shut Down 1986".

Located in the beautiful Terrapin Ridge area of northwestern Illinois within sight of the Mississippi River and historic Galena, Illinois, the Illinois Chapter held its most successful annual Chapter meeting and concourse on August 22nd through 24th. The event was preceded by two road tours which departed from the northern and western suburbs of the Chicago metropolitan area, which were comprised respectively of eight and eighteen Corvettes, together with appropriate "pit crews". The road tours arrived at the Galena Territory; a distance of approximately one hundred forty miles, at mid-afternoon Friday, August 22nd. Meet participants immediately busied themselves by locating their Inn rooms, condominiums, or Territory homes prior to the official commencement of weekend activities that evening. Weather was beautiful; sunny and 75 degrees. Definite "tops down" weather!

"Shut Down 1986" commenced Friday evening with a burger and brat reception overlooking beautiful Lake Galena. Meet participants then retired to the Corvette corral parking area for a unique Illinois Chapter happening called "Tune-Up Night"! Here long-time friends and new arrivals enjoyed each other's conviviality and a great deal of Corvette talk. The informal social gathering amidst nearly fifty Corvettes under a starlit sky within the rolling hills of northwestern Illinois and the Galena Territory provided an excellent backdrop and beginning for what was to be a special weekend.

Saturday, August 23rd, dawned cool and overcast, but concourse participants were ready. Concourse vehicles were staged together in one of two classed; cars to be judged, and cars to be displayed. The Illinois Chapter has had great luck in

encouraging members who have previously had cars judged to continue to drive them and display them in our "display class" long after they have been retired from judging. Twenty-three vehicles were judged and an additional fifteen displayed in a picturesque setting overlooking the hills of the Galena Territory and Lake Galena. Before Saturday's judging concluded, overcast skies gave way to brilliant sunshine and a warm breeze. As judging concluded, Chapter members, families, and guests headed for the swimming pool, the tennis courts, horseback riding, or just some free time for "bench racing".

Saturday evening was highlighted by an outdoor steak fry overlooking Lake Galena. Everyone came together for the second evening in a row to enjoy the beautiful sunset and warm weather.

Sunday morning featured the official business meeting, program, and awards presentation as part of a breakfast buffet. Judging awards were presented, 1986/1987 officers were elected, and members heard from Dave Burroughs, a fellow NCRS member and the man behind Bloomington Gold as the program's featured speaker.

The awards presentation was highlighted by two special recognitions. Jim and Karen Sendelbach, of Henry, Illinois, received a top flight award for their 1967 Big Block Coupe, which garnered high point honors in the concourse judging. Don and Joanne Rich, of New Lenox, Illinois, garnered high point honors for their 1966 Small Block Roadster, and received the Chapter's own "John R. Gasienica Tune-Up Night Award" for the high point car both driven and judged at the annual meet. Named and presented in honor of the Chapter's late Vice President, the award is presented annually, and is specifically intended to encourage the continued driving and showing of 1953 - 1972 Corvettes.

"Shut Down 1986" concluded at noon, Sunday, August 24th, as members departed in two road tours. It had been an eventful weekend, but the best was yet to come! The northbound road tour had one last surprise; a police road block in Stockton, Illinois, which resulted from a "minor misunderstanding" over a gasoline credit card charge by Illinois member and National Director, Carl Strom (who, incidentally, drove two Corvettes to the meet). Carl was lucky in that the Chapter's legal counsel was present in the same road tour, and with cooler heads prevailing and a quick back-track of over twenty miles, the alleged violation of Illinois law was dropped! It had been a memorable weekend.

We now look forward and extend an invitation to you, the members of NCRS, to join us at "Shut Down 1987", August 28 - 30, 1987, at the Galena Territory.


