





In what is rapidly becoming a Midwest tradition, the Illinois Chapter of the National Corvette Restorers Society held its annual meet and concourse at beautiful Eagle Ridge Resort, in Galena, Illinois. Situated in the beautiful northwest section of Illinois overlooking the Mississippi River, the Resort is one of the finest and most picturesque settings anywhere in the Midwest. Meet participants from Illinois, Wisconsin, Indiana, Minnesota, and Iowa shared a unique family Corvette weekend in the finest tradition of family events established by NCRS.

As is the custom with the Illinois Chapter, rain played games with our minds, and the entire Executive Committee held its breath as August 28th approached. Following the wettest August on record in Illinois, we were all wondering if Mother Nature would "do it again"! However, much to our relief, the skies broke and cleared Friday, August 28th, as the road tour departed the Chicago metropolitan area bound for Galena. After a brief stop at Northern Illinois University to pick up our now famous "pit crew", the tour merged with other meet participants at Oregon, Illinois, in the beautiful Rock River Valley. Following lunch and the required "topping off" of fuel tanks on thirsty Corvettes, the road tour wound its way to Savannah, Illinois, and up the Great River Road, along the mighty Mississippi, arriving at the Galena Territory in early afternoon. We had arrived, and now it was time to check in and relax.

"Shutdown, 1987" officially commenced Friday evening with an outdoor barbeque overlooking Lake Galena. Under a beautiful sky and warm breezes, meet participants had ample opportunity to meet new friends and greet old ones.

Dinner was immediately followed by "tune-up night", a unique social experience amidst Corvettes, in the Corvette Corral. Here new and old friends swapped stories, carried on technical conversations, and enjoyed many of the great Corvettes which had arrived. Still under the threat of possible rain, we all wondered what tomorrow would bring.

Saturday, August 29th, dawned with a thick blanket of fog covering the hills of Northwestern Illinois and the Galena Territory. Many of us wondered whether meet participants due in that morning would be able to make it. At 7:00 a.m., the Judge's

Breakfast commenced, and by 8:00, cars were being staged by class on the judging field, despite the fog. Slowly, other participants' cars began to arrive, and hair raising stories of near zero visibility were recounted. By 9:00 a.m., forty Corvettes were staged on the concourse field for judging and display, and the sun was beginning to burn off the fog.


As in the past, in an effort to encourage members to continue to drive their cars and display them, the Illinois Chapter offered its Display Class. Several cars which had previously been removed from judging were displayed, together with vehicles to be judged. As the morning progressed, fog gave way to a brilliant blue sky, warm breezes, and 76 degree temperatures. As judging concluded, families, friends and guests headed off to their favorite recreational activities, or just some relaxation.

Saturday evening, meet participants were treated to a pig roast on Outlook Point, overlooking Lake Galena. The clear skies and warm breezes which had typified the day gave way to a brilliant sunset and star filled sky, as the evening concluded. A number of undisclosed meet participants were reported to have followed dinner with an impromptu road tour into Galena for some heavy duty rock and roll.

Sunday's award presentation was preceded by a buffet breakfast, and highlighted by the presentation of flight awards to meet participants. Gary and Rosey Bosselman, of Roscoe, Illinois, received honors for the high point car (99.9%), for their beautiful 1970 LT-1 Coupe. Terry and Liz McManmon, of Berwyn, Illinois, received the Chapter's own "John R. Gasienica Tune-Up Night Award" for the high point car both driven and judged at the annual meet for their 1971 LT-1 Coupe. A special award was presented to Bob Jourdain, of Alton, Illinois, in recognition of his 1963 Corvette Coupe, a Duntov Award winner which was specially displayed on the concourse field.

The meet concluded with an extensive photo session for meet participants desiring to photograph cars. Cars were staged and photographed in a variety of poses in picturesque settings; all of which should lead to some lasting memories of another great weekend.

The Illinois Chapter now turns its attention to "Shutdown, 1988". We extend an invitation to all NCRS members to participate in this unique family event August 11, 12, and 13, 1988, at Eagle Ridge Resort, the Galena Territory, Galena, Illinois.


